## The Following Is Effective Immediately and Will Remain in Effect Until Further Notice

<u>Maintenance Department</u>: We wanted to share with you some pertinent updates related to novel coronavirus / COVID-19 that most directly impact our staff the BRI has made the following recommendations and High Meadow will follow them:

a.) Given the current inability to determine who may have been infected with the coronavirus even without developing symptoms and the inability to differentiate between residents who are working from home as opposed to residents who are undergoing self or mandatory quarantine, we strongly recommend that all non-emergency repairs in apartments be suspended.
